Per Section 3-11-1 of the Village Code, "Garage Sale" means a sale or an offer for sale of miscellaneous items to the general public upon residential property not otherwise used for commercial purposes also includes "lawn sale," "backyard sale," "yard sale," "attic sale," "rummage sale," "flea market sale." Garage Sales are subject to the following Regulations:

- A. It is unlawful to conduct more than six garage sales during a calendar year on a property zoned for residential use. Each garage sale may last up to, but not more than, three consecutive calendar days and any part of a calendar day during which a garage sale is conducted shall constitute one day.
- B. Garage sales may only be conducted during the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.
- C. A garage sale permit issued by the Village Clerk must be posted in a conspicuous location where the sale is conducted.
- D. No person shall sell or offer for sale at a garage sale items other than used and discarded items of personal property.
- E. The permit holder for a garage sale is responsible for and shall ensure adequate and safe parking for the duration of the garage sale. At no time shall the permit holder cause or allow the obstruction of any Village street, alley, sidewalk, right-of-way, or other public areas used for travel by the public.
- F. Items offered for sale shall not be displayed on public rights-of-way including sidewalks, streets, and alleys.
- G. Items offered for sale shall not be displayed on exterior property before the first day or after the final day of the garage sale.
- H. Signs advertising a garage sale shall not be placed on traffic signs, public utility poles, or upon public rights-of-way.
- I. Signs advertising a garage sale must be removed within twenty-four hours following the conclusion of the garage sale.
